

Air Navigation Pro app now enhanced by AIS from skyguide

Geneva, 3 July 2014. The Air Navigation Pro application is now enhanced by skyguide's Aeronautical Information Services. skyguide, the swiss air navigation service provider, delivers a comprehensive set of aeronautical information services to Xample for their popular navigation software Air Navigation Pro. The services include the licensing of eVFR Manual data, access to the SmartNOTAM database for highly tailored NOTAM briefings as well as flight plan processing functions. Xample started offering eVFR Manual data and SmartNOTAM briefings in early 2013 and has successfully launched the additional ATC flight plan filing functionality as of 1st of May 2014.

skyguide AIM pursues a strategy to act as the authoritative data source for aeronautical information and to provide that information through secure web services to software developers serving the aviation industry.

Air Navigation Pro is used by over 100'000 customers worldwide who will benefit from the new services and information from a trusted source. The new ATC flight plan filing service enables Air Navigation Pro users to file their flight plan from their mobile devices worldwide. The flight plan is processed by skyguide's AIM operation located in Wangen bei Dübendorf, Switzerland. The two companies plan to further extend their cooperation with additional services.

SmartNOTAM Service by skyguide provides permanent and automatic update of the SmartNOTAM and the associated standard NOTAM as received by the publishing source. The SmartNOTAM are forwarded to customer's database by continuous electronic transfer of structured information or might be taken from a Webservice. SmartNOTAM are individually screened, continuously updated and edited according to a fix set of rules, easy readability and focusing on operational significance for individual flights.

This service allows through the philosophy of its processing and production for relevant reduced duty time of crews and less pre-processing through the supporting functions such as flight planning, dispatch, while at the same time supports safer operations.
